



# DESTINATIONS

#### Bariloche, ARGENTINA

Bariloche is the gateway to the Lake District of Argentina and was the first city to be established in Patagonia, located west of the province of Río Negro. It is located in the heart of the Nahuel Huapi National Park, the oldest national park in the country. Located south of the lake that gives its name to the park, the destination combines both the city lifestyle and the tranquility of nature.





### ITINERARY

# Day 1: Buenos Aires 🚧 Bariloche

Arrival at Bariloche airport, meeting your guide and transfer to your hotel of choice.

#### Circuito Chico - HD

This is a tour intended for those who wish to stop, enjoy and truly savor life and the stunning views that can be seen in this extraordinary area. Along the Circuito Chico route, there will be many natural views to enjoy, such as López Bay and the Panoramic Point. The chairlift to Cerro Campanario, located approximately at the midpoint of the excursion (17 km), is at the right height to fully appreciate the most magnificent view of the area. In addition to the landscape, there will be a wide range of regional products to discover: handmade textiles, wood, ceramics, candles, cosmetics and many others.

### Day 2: Bariloche

Breakfast at the hotel.

#### Route of the 7 Lakes – FD

On this tour, you will travel along National Route 40 for about 21 km from San Carlos de Bariloche, until it connects with National Route 231 and from there you will head west. Some sections of the road will border Lake Nahuel Huapi in a unique way, revealing Cerro Cathedral in the background. After passing Puerto Manzano, you will cross Villa La Angostura, a true mountain town, characterized by its meticulous and clean architecture. A few kilometers later the Seven Lakes Trail will begin, following lakes Correntoso, Espejo, Escondido, Villarino, Falkner, Hermoso and Machonico. Each site will have its own unique landscape and all will be surrounded by lush forests. Once in San Martín de los Andes, on the shores of



Lake Lacar, you can explore the city and visit a particularly interesting viewpoint. Return to Bariloche.

# Day 3: Bariloche 🚧 Buenos Aires

Breakfast at the hotel.

#### Isla Victoria - HD

Departing from Puerto Pañuelo and after sailing for 1 hour, you will reach the Quetrihué Peninsula where you will visit the only Myrtles forest in the world. During the walk along the wooden walkways, you can see these 100-year-old trees. Then we will sail for 40 minutes to Victoria Island to disembark in Puerto Anchorena. Here you can see other conifers, enjoy a panoramic point and walk along several trails, one of which will lead to Playa del Toro where you can see cave paintings or relax on the volcanic sand beaches.



Transfer to Bariloche Airport to take your flight.
