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Doctor Corvalán is a medical-doctor, Master in Public Health and a PhD in Nutrition from Emory University. She is Associate Professor of the Public Nutrition Unit of the Institute of Nutrition and Food Technology (INTA) of the University of Chile. She is also Director and principal investigator of the Center for Research in Food Environments and Prevention of Nutrition-Related Chronic Diseases (CIAPEC), at INTA of the University of Chile.

Her lines of research focus on the population study of the early nutritional determinants of obesity and nutrition-related chronic diseases. She participates in the evaluation of public policies and technical advice to state agencies in Chile and abroad, among which carries out policy evaluations such as the Chilean Labeling Law and Advertising stands out. It is also part of international cooperation networks for monitoring food environments, such as INFORMAS.
