DESTINATION

Iguazú Falls, ARGENTINA/BRAZIL

Iguazú Falls is an enormous waterfall that lies on the border between Argentina and Brazil. Unlike many places in Argentina or Brazil, the name isn't Spanish or Portuguese. The word iguazú actually derives from the Tupi or Guarani languages, meaning 'big water' — which is fitting, considering the falls' sheer scale. Iguazú Falls is one of the most spectacular waterfalls in the world, with a multi-story cascade that stretches over 1.7 miles. If you break it down, Iguazú Falls actually comprises 275 separate waterfalls, with heights varying from 200 feet to 269 feet.





ITINERARY

Day 1: Buenos Aires 🔀 Iguazú

Arrival to Puerto Iguazú's Airport, meeting with your guide.

Brazilian National Park Visit.

On this tour, you will go to the Iguaçu National Park, on the Brazilian side of the falls, where you will discover secure and modern catwalks that lead through the falls. Then you will continue down the pathways, which takes you over the falling water up to a special area with a fantastic panoramic view of the Devil's Throat and the surrounding falls.



Visit Bird Park

After visiting the National Park of Brazil, you will enter the world of nature. Rare and colorful tropical birds blend into the lush, moist green wood. Visitors will have the opportunity to enter these garden centers to admire bird life up close. In addition, there are crocodiles, anacondas, boas, monkeys, titi and butterflies that surprise visitors.



At the end of the tour, return to the hotel.

Rest of the day free for your enjoyment.

Overnight in Iquazu.



Day 2: Iguazú

Breakfast at the hotel.

Argentinian National Park Visit.

You will enjoy a tour, visiting the 3 main circuits that will bring you face-to-face with the native wildlife: the Lower and Upper circuits and - most impressive - the Devil's Throat. The Iguazú River plunges into a gorge of over 275 falls spread along 4 km and completely surrounded by a dense, tropical forest. The Upper Circuit guarantees spectacular panoramic views of the falls. The Lower Circuit will give you closer contact with the falls and the surrounding vegetation. Finally, you will arrive at the Devil's Throat, the most impressive waterfall in Iguazú.



Gran Aventura Navigation - optional

First you will travel in an open vehicle one of the most emblematic roads of the Iguazú National Park: the Yacaratiá trail. With the help of a bilingual guide, you will discover the natural links that make this landscape one of the most biodiverse in the world.

Then, in a fully equipped boat, we go up the wild rapids of the river and take you to the foot of the most impressive falls of the Iguazú Falls. You will have time for some memorable photographs and finally the underwater baptism of the jumps will come.



Return to the hotel in the afternoon.



Overnight in Iguazu.

Day 3: Iguazú Buenos Aires

Breakfast at the hotel.

At the appropriate time, transfer to the Puerto Iguazú Airport to take your flight.
